Dissemination & Development of Minimum Service Standards (SPM) for the District of Manokwari Selatan

Minimum Service Standards for Basic Education (SPM Dikdas) is one of the benchmark of performance for basic services in education. Regulation of Minister of Education and Culture No. 23 of 2013 stipulates that the provision of basic education that is in line with Minimum Service Standards (MSS) shall fall under the jurisdiction of District/Municipality governments. To improve the quality of basic education services through the implementation of MSS for primary school education in the villages, the Ministry of Education and Culture in collaboration with the Provincial Government of Papua Barat and the District of Manokwari Selatan organised the dissemination and development of minimum service standards for basic education in three subdistricts at the District of Manokwari Selatan.

The event was held for three days from 13-15 July 2017, attended by approximately 100 participants comprising of school principals, teachers, and members of school committee, school supervisors, heads of subdistrict, heads of kampung (villages) and community leaders from 26 Primary Schools. The training and the development of Education MSS was simultaneously held in 3 subdistricts, i.e. Subdistricts of Oransbari, Ransiki and Momi Waren in the District of Manokwari Selatan, Papua Barat Province.
